

2016 Local Craft Championship



Associated Builders and Contractors, Texas Gulf Coast Chapter held its annual local Craft Championship at Brazosport College on October 27th, 2016.

Participants competed against their peers for a chance to compete in the National ABC Craft Championships to be held in Fort Lauderdale, Florida, February 28, 2017 – March 3, 2017.

This year, the millwright craft was represented in competition with the support of Mr. Jim Slick, Coordinator, Brazosport College Machinist and Millwright Divisions. Local competitors met certain criteria which included active enrollment in craft training within the past 6 months, employment through an ABC Texas Gulf Coast member company, and completion of the 1st two levels of their craft with a "B" or better average. The local competition consisted of both written knowledge assessment and performance verifications. In determining a final score, the written portion accounted for 25% and the performance portion accounted for 75%.

The ABC Public Relations Committee organizes various activities to assist within the community during the year. The Annual ABC Cook-off helps to raise funds to benefit the area charitable organizations. On October 25, 2016 the Public Relations Committee presented funds to these charities:

Below is a brief description of information and services provided by the 4-named charitable organizations:



BRAZORIA COUNTY DREAM CENTER

Mission Statement: Brazoria County Dream Center (BCDC) is a non-profit community outreach center dedicated to helping children and adults in Brazoria County who are experiencing hardships. We address both the physical and emotional needs of our constituents. We accomplish this by focusing on rebuilding hope, renewing lives and restoring dreams.

Vision Statement:

Rebuilding Hope to those who are experiencing life difficulties by providing basic essentials such as food, clothing and other resources to help families in those difficult times.

Renewing Lives to those who are experiencing life challenges by meeting their emotional needs through life rehabilitation and networking with other community agencies.

Restoring Dreams to those who have lost hope by enhancing their potential to succeed through educational classes and other resources that will improve basic life skills.

Within BCDC, we have seven separate programs that allow us to achieve these goals:

Backpack Buddies Program: Providing backpacks with nutritional food and snacks to 375 students weekly at 25 schools in 6 school districts in Southern Brazoria County since January 2010.

Dream Pantry: Providing an atmosphere of a grocery store with added nutritional information for healthy living, to 200 unduplicated families per month since February 2010.

Elaine's Boutique: Providing free clothing, personal care items, diapers, cleaning supplies and other household items as needed to 210 unduplicated families per month, since April 2007.

Back 2 Basic Classes: Providing free basic life skills, education and other resources to enhance the individuals' potential to succeed.

Back to School Bash: Providing school age children who live in Brazoria County with the items needed to start school. Children receive backpacks with school supplies, clothes, new tennis shoes, haircuts, personal care kits and first week of lunches to over 700 students, since August 2009.

Coats 4 Kids: Providing coats, jackets, new blankets and haircuts to students who attend school in Brazoria County, to over 250 students since 2009.

Dream Gifts: Providing Christmas gifts and wrapping paper to Brazoria County families who have had a life crisis that prevents the parents from providing gifts for their children, age infant through 15 years old, to over 600 students *(including 300 bikes)* since 2011.

Disaster Recovery: Most recently, we have assisted those who have been affected by the historic Brazos River flooding this past summer. We have assisted over 240 families (impacting over 1075 individuals) with food, clothing, personal care items, cleaning supplies and household items each week. Each family has a different stage of recovery since the flooding, making each family unique in the items they need per week.

POWERPACKS... FUELING YOUNG MINDS AND BODIES FOR LEARNING

Brazosport Cares Food Pantry's weekend backpack program **POWERPACKS**, provides nutritionally dense, easy to prepare food to homeless and chronically hungry BISD students who would otherwise go home to meager or no meals.

Hunger is a reality many students face on a daily basis. More than 80% of students in Freeport schools are classified as economically disadvantaged and there continues to be a significant presence of homeless students in the district. These students do not have consistent access to enough nutritious food. Many of these children rely on school breakfast and lunch during the school year. However, they go home to little or no meals on weekends and holiday breaks. **POWERPACKS** are designed to help alleviate childhood hunger and remove it as a barrier in the classroom. In addition, the program works to empower students to succeed in school as well as provide them with a tangible expression; that as a community, we care about them.

The **POWERPACKS** program serves seven schools within BISD. Brazosport Cares works with individuals, organizations and the Houston Food Bank to obtain food and supplies necessary to fill the backpacks. Weekly volunteers use these items to fill backpacks for qualifying students. The backpacks are delivered by volunteers to the participating schools at the end of each week. Students take the backpacks home for the weekend and return the empty bag to school on Monday, so the process can start over. This school year, we will pack approximately 2,500 backpacks for more than 150 students.

As a leader in the fight against hunger in the community, Brazosport Cares Food Pantry knows if a student is facing hunger, chances are the entire family is. By connecting the student's family to our pantry program, we are able meet the needs of the entire family.

There are many ways to help! Brazosport Cares relies on the generosity of the community to meet the needs of chronically hungry students. A shopping list of much needed items is available on our website at <u>www.brazosportcares.org</u>. Food donations may be dropped off at Brazosport Cares Tuesday and Thursday mornings 8:30 – 11:30. The Pantry is located at 916 N. Gulf Boulevard, Freeport, TX 77541. Additionally, look for the Red Barrel at the Freeport City Hall, Lake Jackson Library and HEB Lake Jackson, to drop off donations. Volunteers are also needed to fill backpacks on Tuesdays, and to deliver and pickup backpacks to and from schools.

BOY SCOUT TROOP, FREEPORT

Boy Scout Troop #345 chartered at First United Methodist Church in Freeport on November 1, 1961. Since then they have had over 30 boys reach the rank of Eagle Scout, the highest rank that a Scout can earn. The Scouting program teaches the boys to "be prepared" in life and in the outdoors. They learn cooking skills, first aid, knots & lashing, citizenship and leadership.

The troop has helped the community by providing flag ceremony services, cleaning up parks, replacing playground equipment at Freeport parks, providing services to help out wherever needed at Freeport area events, and striving to be a positive presence in the Freeport area.

Most of the boys are from lower income family environments and cannot afford the cost necessary to participate in all the programs that Scouting offers. At Troop 345 we are always looking for ways to obtain funds to help the boys be able to fully participate. We accept donations, but our main goal is to find ways for the boys to work to "earn" their way. It is better to teach them to work for it than to just receive it.


