The Hard Hat Heroes Credentialing Portal allows veterans to receive NCCER credit for skills and training received while in the service. Each individual that meets the criteria can fill out an online application and submit documentation to be reviewed and potentially entered into the NCCER Registry System. The portal consists of 10 Army military occupational specialty (MOS) codes, 36 Navy Seabee rates and 8 Air Force specialty codes (AFSC) that align directly with NCCER craft training, and assists hiring managers in skill identification and training preparation. All alignments within the portal were developed in conjunction with military trainers and industry representatives. More alignments are in development with the other branches of service and are due to release throughout the year. Additionally, Hard Hat Heroes offers FREE online core curriculum.
